This Policy also aims to be the framework for establishing and periodically reviewing these objectives, which aim to guarantee a constant commitment to continuous improvement and the reduction of accidents, through:

- correct and adequate management of Personal Protective Equipment;
- compliance with legislation and fulfillment of required standards through continuous staff training;
- adequate and safe working conditions through the application of precise procedures and operating instructions;
- systematic detection of the causes of problems related to unacceptable residual risks connected to the activities carried out, in order to promptly identify the measures necessary for their rapid resolution and elimination;
- promotion of awareness and respect for safety issues, particularly regarding careful handling and storage of materials, constant control and maintenance of equipment, and careful evaluation and control of chemical and physical agents;
- constant improvement of the working environment, both in terms of safety and health and in terms of interpersonal relationships, promoting the following principles:
 - the affirmation that responsibility for managing the system concerns the entire company organization, from the Employer down to every worker, each according to their own duties and competencies;
 - considering safety and related results as an integral part of company management;
 - optimizing the commitment to prevention;
 - involving workers, also through their safety representatives;
 - disseminating the objectives and related implementation programs within the company.
